

CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION CF 4455

BACKGROUND: The CF 4455, Certificate of Registration is used at time of export from the U.S. when the Exporter anticipates that the merchandise will be re-imported into the U.S. and may be subject to duty upon return. The CF 4455 must be completed by the Exporter and presented to U.S. Customs for inspection prior to export. If metal articles undergo certain processing while out of the country, they will be subject to an assessment of duty upon the advancement in the value of the goods, a statement pursuant to 19 CFR 10.9 must be on the back of the CF 4455.

REMEMBER: IT IS IMPORTANT THAT U.S. CUSTOMS SIGN THIS FORM AND THAT A COPY IS KEPT BY EITHER PBB USA INC. OR YOUR COMPANY.

WITHOUT A SIGNED CF 4455, U.S. CUSTOMS RESERVES THE RIGHT TO NOT ACCEPT ALTERNATIVE DOCUMENTS AS PROOF OF EXPORT. IF SO, YOU MAY HAVE TO PAY DUTY ON THE FULL VALUE.

1. VIA (Carrier) - The name of the carrier that is exporting the goods.
2. B/L OR INSURED NO. - The Bill of Lading number, Airway Bill number, or other shipping number used by the exporting carrier to identify the merchandise.
3. DATE - Today's date.
4. NAME, ADDRESS, AND ZIP CODE TO WHICH CERTIFIED FORM IS TO BE MAILED - Place either the name of your company, if you wish to maintain the form, or:

5. ARTICLES EXPORTED FOR: Check off the block that describes why the articles are being exported (more than one block may be checked).
6. NUMBER OF PACKAGES - Fill in the number of packages being exported.
7. KIND OF PACKAGES - Fill in the type of packages being exported, such as crates, pallets and so on.
8. DESCRIPTION - Fill in a work description of the articles being exported, include values and serial numbers whenever possible.

- 9. SIGNATURE OF OWNER OR AGENT - Type your name and the company's name when completing the form and sign.
- 10. DATE - The date that the form was completed.
- 11. Type the name and address of the U.S. party.
- 12. Type the name and address of the Canadian party.

NOTE:

If metal articles are being exported for processing and then returning to the U.S. for further processing, the following declaration must be completed on the back of the CF 4455:

"The articles described in this certificate were manufactured in the U.S. by _____ (Name and Address) or, if of foreign origin, were subjected to (show processes of manufacture, such as molding, casting, machining, etc.) in the U.S. by _____ (Name and Address). The articles in their changed conditions will be returned for further processing by _____ (Name and Address); or, if further processing of the articles in the U.S. will be performed by a person not presently known, the reasons for believing the articles will be returned for further processing are _____ and the reason the person is not presently known is _____.
